Guidelines:

- The Director of Instrumental Music will coordinate the logistics and schedule of the auditions.
- Candidates/those auditioning must be a full-time Moravian College student.
- All candidates must be enrolled in applied lessons during the semester of the competition. Winners must also be enrolled in applied lessons during the semester of the winners' concert.
- Students are asked to perform a solo work with published, available, accompaniment by orchestra or wind ensemble.
- It is strongly suggested, but not required, that students contact and work with an accompanist for the audition (it is to the students' advantage to play with an accompanist at the audition).
- Candidates will be asked to fill out an application that needs to be signed by his/her teacher (instructor of the instrument on which they will audition).
- Winners will be chosen through auditions held in the spring semester.
- Winners must perform the same work for both the competition and performance unless approved by the director.
- The date of the spring semester auditions will be decided upon by the directors of the Moravian College Wind Ensemble and Moravian College Community Orchestra, along with consultation with the Music Department Chair.
- Candidates will be heard and judged by the directors of the wind ensemble and orchestra.
- Winners will perform their selection the following academic year accompanied either by the wind ensemble or orchestra.
- Once a student musician has won the concerto competition as an underclassman, they cannot audition again.
- Rules, regulations, dates and application forms will be posted on the Moravian College Music Department website.
- The ensemble directors reserve the right to award only one (or no) solo awards, if they deem necessary.
- Once applications have been turned in, the ensemble directors will assign audition times.
- Accompanists will be paid the same fee/scale/rate as for performance class.
