Clinical includes practicum, capstone, simulation, and/or other internship experiences. Hours are scheduled according to the preceptor's availability. Students' work schedules are not permitted to interfere with their clinical experiences.

To be successful in the program, nurse practitioner students are expected to reduce work hours or not to work at all during their clinical year. Faculty will not be responsible for adjusting clinical assignments due to work conflicts. These hours are completed to assure that students have substantive opportunities to develop in their specialty roles (1 cr. Clinical credit = 50+ contact hours).
