The Moravian University Health Center is managed by St Luke's Hospital through the St. Luke's Hospital Occupational Health Program and provides a variety of services during the fall and spring terms. A division of Student Life, the unit provides health and wellness care to the university community through diagnosis and treatment, education, and response to the needs and interests of the students.

Doctors' hours are by appointment.

- All visits to the Health Center **must be scheduled** by calling 610.861.1567 or emailing healthcenter@moravian.edu.
- Everyone will be screened via phone or email prior to scheduling an appointment.
- Appointments will either be scheduled via video visit or in person.
- In person visits for TB testing, allergy shots and some sick visits will require screening prior to entry to the Health Center in addition to the daily electronic screening

There is no charge to visit the University Health Center. Insurance will be utilized if a specimen is collected on site that needs further testing at a local laboratory.

STUDENT HEALTH RECORDS

Student health records are maintained in a shared record in the Health Centers EMR (electronic medical record - called Pyramed). It is the student's responsibility to maintain the currency of required health documents in the electronic system in accordance with the School of Nursing and Public Health Policy. The School of Nursing will have access to these files and may need to release some or all health records to the affiliating clinical agencies who may request them. A consent form is signed by the student prior to enrollment to release health forms as needed.
