In addition, ten student-athletes earned All-America status, including one *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-American and one national champion in track & field.

A Division III institution, Moravian has excellent athletics facilities, including the venerable Johnston Hall, Breidegam Fieldhouse, and the Steel Field athletics complex, including Sportex Turf on Rocco Calvo Field and an eight-lane, Olympic-quality Mondo track, both installed in 2005.

The College has a strong sense of identity and purpose firmly rooted in a long and rich tradition. Both in and out of the classroom, Moravian and its students maintain that tradition.

## Head Coach Jim Walker

**Jim Walker** has served as head basketball since 1979. **Walker** has also been interim athletics director twice at Moravian College. He held the athletics director position from the summer of 1996 to May 1998 and resumed the title in July of 1999 until July of 2000.

On the basketball floor, **Walker** is the winningest basketball coach in Moravian history and has compiled a 382-347 record, earning his 300th career victory in January of 2002. **Walker** has guided the 'Hounds to two NCAA tournament appearances including one last season and nine conference playoff berths, including 1996's MAC Commonwealth League crown. Four **Walker** coached teams have earned national rankings and his 1982-83 and 1987-88 teams set a record with 19 wins.

**Walker** was Moravian's men's tennis coach from 1979 until 2009, and his career includes the 1996 Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League championship and several conference playoffs appearances including a berth in the 2009 Landmark Conference Championship match. He was a ranked player in the Middle States Tennis Association, and is a teaching member of the Professional Tennis Registry.

**Walker**, who has a career basketball coaching mark of 396-359 over 30 years, earned a B.A. in history from Gettysburg College, where he played varsity basketball and tennis, and earned a master's degree in education from Rider College.

## 2009-10 Season Preview

The 2009-10 Moravian College men's basketball team looks to continue to make a return to the postseason this year after missing the Landmark Conference Tournament a year ago. The Greyhounds are also looking to win their first-ever Landmark Conference Championship going into this season. Head coach **Jim Walker**, who enters his 30th season at the school, has ten letterwinners returning and three starters back from last year's 10-15 squad.

Senior forward **Eric Weaver (Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS)** leads the returning Greyhounds after averaging 13.3 points per game to go along with 18 steals, 34 assists and 125 rebounds a year ago. **Weaver** also led the team in free throw percentage, shooting 112-135 (83.0 percent).

Sophomore guard **Sergio Camacho (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** averaged 10.3 points per game to go along with 23 steals, 33 assists, and 42 rebounds. **Camacho** led the team from beyond the arc hitting 49 three-pointers in his first season as a Greyhound. Junior forward **Chris Cullen (East Islip, NY/East Islip HS)** contributed 201 points last season while grabbing 95 rebounds, 16 steals, and 18 blocks.

Sophomore guard/forward **Nelson Leon (Reading, PA/Reading HS)** recorded 114 points, 23 assists, seven blocks and 69 rebounds in his first collegiate season while sophomore forward **Jeff Cullinan (Bridgewater, NJ/Immaculata HS)** posted 82 points and 36 rebounds on the year.

Sophomore forward **Shane Painter (Bedminster, NJ/Bernards HS)** knocked down 84 points, ten steals, 12 assists and 53 rebounds while junior forward **Alvin Adams (Newark, NJ/Marist HS)** contributed 66 points, nine steals, 93 rebounds, and a team leading 22 blocked shots.

Senior forward **Joseph Munley (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** returns for his final season after he recorded 36 points, seven steals, 12 assists and 49 rebounds. Junior guard **Ryan O'Donnell (Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS)** had 19 points, four steals, 11 assists and 14 rebounds while sophomore forward **Mark Koelbel (Bayport, NY/Bayport-Blue Point HS)** contributed ten points and seven rebounds in limited action in his first year as a Greyhound.

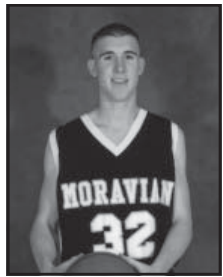
Coach **Walker** has once again brought in a strong recruiting class for Moravian and looks for the Greyhounds to return to the postseason and challenge for the Landmark Conference Championship.

The Greyhounds begin their 2009-10 season against Lebanon Valley College on Sunday, November 15th before a trip to the Scotty Wood Tournament in Allentown. Moravian will also host the 32nd Annual Greyhound Starters Classic in early January.

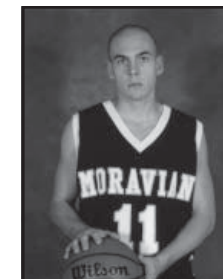

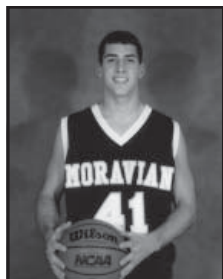
