Advanced Level Training

Players with upper level abilities will be grouped together and given additional training during camp. This will include conditioning, strategy, mental training and individual match analysis. This will help high school and tournament players reach their full potential.

PROGRAM

The daily schedule will be structured so that each camper will receive instruction, and competition on a daily basis. On the first day of camp, each camper will be placed in a group with others of similar abilities, so that instruction can be personalized. During the week our own video tape equipment will be used for stroke analysis of all campers. Each camper will receive a personal evaluation at the end of camp. At the Greyhound Tennis Camp we stress attention for the individual camper. Our campers primarily come from Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and New York, but we have had campers from 15 states and five countries. Players include all ability levels and many of the top players in the Lehigh Valley have attended Greyhound Tennis Camp.

SUPERVISION

All activities at the camp will be supervised. Adult counselors are housed in the dormitories with campers for 24 hour supervision and are available to handle any emergencies. Campers are required to attend all camp activities and abide by Moravian College rules and regulations. Smoking tobacco, the possession or consumption of illegal drugs and the use of alcoholic beverages are strictly forbidden. Violations of this policy will subject the camper to parent notification, and immediate dismissal from camp without refund of camp fees.

EXCELLENT FACILITIES

Moravian College is located in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania. The beautiful campus will be the site for the Greyhound Tennis Camp. Requests for roommates will be granted. Dormitory rooms are semi-private and shared by 2 campers. The dormitories are also air-conditioned. Three balanced and nutritious meals will be served daily in the dining hall. The Union building and other facilities are available for various activities. T.V., lounge and laundry facilities are located in the dormitory. Both on campus and off campus tennis facilities will be used. Our own college indoor courts will be used on rainy days.
