Photo ID Cards and Parking Permits

Every individual taking courses at Moravian College is required to have a current Moravian College photo ID card. Any student who wishes to park in College lots or on the streets around the campus must have a valid parking permit. You need to wait three days after registration.

New students may obtain a photo ID and parking permit at the same time. ID cards and parking permits are available free of charge at the Campus Safety Office, 119 W. Greenwich Street to Comenius Center students. Please see times below for obtaining passes.

To obtain a parking permit, please bring your original (no copies)

1. Driver's license
2. Vehicle registration card (for each vehicle)
3. Insurance card

If you have questions, please contact the Campus Safety Office, which is staffed 24 hours a day, at 610 861-1421.

Returning students who already hold a parking hangtag must have a sticker for the current academic year affixed to the hangtag. Stickers may be obtained at the Campus Safety Office at the address and times listed below. If you need a sticker, please bring your parking hangtag, driver's license, vehicle registration card (for each vehicle), insurance card, and College ID. Plastic photo IDs remain valid as long as you are currently registered for classes.

New Students: You will be able to obtain your student ID and parking hangtag on the evening of New Student Orientation (August 24). Returning Students and New Students not able to attend Orientation – please follow schedule below:

Computer Logons and Resources

Logons are a vital link to the Moravian campus for access to library databases, Blackboard, e-mail, grades, and account balances. You must access your Moravian e-mail regularly (you may do this on or off campus) to receive official information.

If you are new to Moravian, you may pick up your logon at the Center for Information Technology (CIT) Help Desk, located on the first floor of Memorial Hall. Help Desk hours are 7:00 am – 7:30 pm, Monday – Thursday and 7:00 am – 4:30 pm on Friday. If you register within 2 days before the start of classes, your logon will be available 72 hours after registration. If you have attended Moravian previously but do not currently have a logon or have forgotten your password, please visit the CIT Help Desk. You may speak with a Help Desk technician by calling 610 625-7929.

A microcomputer lab, available 24 hours a day, is located in Hamilton Hall (accessed via the back door of the building). Your student ID card is required for admission to the lab. Reeves Library also has 22 PCs that may be used during the library's open hours. You may also use any of the publicly accessible classroom computers when classes are not in session.
