DEFERRED PAYMENT PLAN

The Moravian College Graduate Studies and Continuing Education Department provides several methods of tuition payment. Payments involving cash and personal checks can be directly submitted to the Bursar's Office. Credit card payments, such as VISA, MasterCard and Discover are accepted online via AMOS on CASHNet.

In addition, Moravian College makes available a Deferred Payment Plan. Under this plan the tuition cost is divided into three payments: 40% of the total cost of tuition is due on a specified date prior to the beginning of classes; and two additional payments (30% each) are due on specified dates on the calendar. A modest application fee is applied at the time of the first payment to cover administrative costs.

Additional fees such as those for laboratory, technology, studio art supplies, music lessons, etc. are not included in the plan; they are due in full with registration or with the first tuition payment.

The student is asked to complete and sign the application to signify agreement to meet the fee schedule on time. The student will receive a copy of the agreement as a record and as a reminder of the due dates and amounts due. To keep administrative costs to a minimum, there is no advance billing. It is the student's responsibility to pay on time. A \$50 late charge is immediately due and payable if an installment is not paid on its due date.
