DAY 1 SATURDAY, AUGUST 22 NEWARK

Gather at Moravian College at 6:00 pm and travel by charter bus to Newark International Airport and board your CONTINENTAL AIRLINES Transatlantic Flight #110, departing at 10:10 pm for London. Enjoy meals and snacks enroute and arrive the next morning with a grand time of sightseeing, touring, fun, and exploring ahead!

DAY 6 THURSDAY, AUGUST 27 LONDON / EXCURSION TO STONEHENGE & BATH

In the morning we will travel west to the Salisbury Plain and Britain's most important monument, Stonehenge. This huge megalithic structure, in all probability of religious significance, dates from between 1850 and 1400 BC. Next stop for lunch and then continue on to the medieval town of Bath, one of England's most picturesque towns. First popularized by the Romans who discovered the natural hot springs here, Bath was and still is the most celebrated spa in England and the only resort with hot springs. Afterwards, transfer to your hotel.

DAY 7 FRIDAY, AUGUST 28 LONDON / EXCURSION TO OXFORD & WARWICK
