- 4. Representatives from the music department and Sam Rosas facilitated a conversation in Performance Class today to better understand what issues we should focus on. We address the following:
 - Parking issues; students are getting Lehigh tickets when they have a permit. The school told us to move to that lot.
 Bring tickets to Campus Police; they will contact the town for you! Supposed to refund Spring Street Parkers but have not emailed everyone yet. No crosswalk either.
 - Viv will let Campus Police know
 - Shuttles could be improved. Could be more predictable & timely. Update the system. Clearer schedule.
 - Shuttle could visit Lehigh Street, Lot Q
 - A way to notify the shuttle if a student is waiting in a spot
 - No shuttle driver on Saturday
 - Mileage is further from Lehigh Street to the Hill than from Lot X to HUB
 - Parking lot (commuters & faculty), lines need to be repainted, you can't see anything. Very narrow spaces
 - Classes being scheduled during large ensembles is a big issue
 - Inconsistent air conditioning, elevators are always broken, door alarms on the 5th & 2nd floors are always going off, and water turns cold very quickly in the Hill and Main-Clewell.
 - Clewell dining hall hours are very inconvenient, there are a lot of kids who don't have the opportunity to eat in the morning. Even if it was only an hour earlier, it would be more convenient
 - Meal costs for people without meal plans are very expensive
