













#### Q11 Please reflect on your expectations of the graduate program when you entered. How satisfied are you now with the program given your original expectations?







## Q15 For MBA and MSHRM students, what is your concentration or track of study?



#### Q16 In which county do you reside?



## Q17 Do you work outside of the Lehigh Valley (Lehigh and Northampton Counties)?




