# The Moravian College *Add-Venture* Experience A Nontraditional Curricular Approach

#### What is the *Add-Venture Program*?

- *The Add-Venture Program* allows students maximum flexibility in choosing and justifying their programs of undergraduate studies.
- *Add-Venture* is an opportunity for students who wish to pursue an academic program that is either not generally offered or that would be impossible to complete through the Learning in Common approach.

### Who is the *Add-Venture Program* for?

• The *Add-Venture* program is designed for students with two or three academic areas of interest.

## Who will be admitted into the Add-Venture Program?

- The program is designed for students of exceptional maturity who are entering college with a clear sense of direction and a good understanding of their personal goals.
- The committee selects Add-Venture candidates by evaluating the required essay as well as the applicant's high school records, letters of recommendation, and SAT scores.

#### What are the benefits of the *Add-Venture Program*?

- The *Add-Venture Program* is basically a liberal arts education designed especially for you!
- Students invited to enroll in *Add-Venture* will work closely with a faculty mentor designated to guide them through their entire course of study at Moravian College.

# How to apply to the *Add-Venture* program:

Please write a brief essay (no more than two typed, double-spaced pages) that addresses the following points:

- Explain how the freedom of the *Add-Venture Program* will help you meet your educational, personal, and vocational goals.
- What experiences have you had that you would consider important? Tell us about your background so that we can make an informed decision about your application.
- What attracts you to this individualized approach to a liberal education?
