

Adding Time Accommodations to a Canvas Quiz

1. Create the quiz for the whole class as you normally would.
2. Edit the quiz as follows:
 - Add a time limit for the entire class.
 - Scroll to the bottom; under **Assign To**, click **+Add**.

3. Select the student (s) with accommodations from the dropdown. Be sure to extend the **Until** date for as long as needed, factoring in the additional time that you plan to give the student. Then hit **Save**.
