EDUC 642 - ARTS EDUCATION FOR SOCIAL CHANGE

Mondays and Wednesdays | May 22 - June 29, 2017 | 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. | Dr. Debra Torok

Arts Education for Social Change is a course that introduces the integration of arts education and social awareness. Students will examine how the arts affect social outcome and how the international artistic community in the visual, performing, and literary arts responds to human and environmental rights issues. Students will examine visual art such as drawing, painting, graphic design, sculpture, photography, and video; performing art including music, dance, and theater; literary art such as fiction and non-fiction writing and poetry; and various forms of social media. In viewing artists as advocates for social change, students will evaluate art works and issues suitable for the classroom and categorize age appropriate resources.

EDUC 616 - DRAMA IN EDUCATION

Participants will explore the use of drama to facilitate student learning in the content areas, K-12, and will construct thematically-based curricula that incorporate drama-in- education principles. Theories of dramatic art and historical uses of drama and theatre to promote mindful learning will be examined.

EDUC 590 - THE ART OF CONDUCTING

The Art of Conducting is an intensive six-week long graduate level course dedicated to the development of advanced conducting techniques. Students will work with experts in wind, orchestral, and choral conducting areas on issues such as repertoire development, effective rehearsal strategy, conducting gestures, ensemble recruitment and retention, and score study. Students will have the opportunity to conduct significant repertoire with ensemble musicians in a rehearsal setting and receive appropriate feedback from the instructors.
