Approved students may sign a lease once released and provide the College with their offcampus address before August 1.

The College anticipates releasing approximately 50 students for the 2019-2020 academic year.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS?

- Junior or senior, or 20 years of age by the first day of the fall semester
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Good financial and conduct standing
