

APPLICATION INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS F-1 VISAS 2019 - 2020 ACADEMIC YEAR

Thank you for your interest in attending Moravian College in Bethlehem, PA USA. Any student who is, or intends to be, in the United States on a Student Visa (F-1) is considered an international student. In order to issue the application for the student F-1 Visa (SEVIS I-20 form,) you must submit the following documents:

First-year International students are required to submit the following:

- Moravian College online application at: https://www.moravian.edu/admissions/international/requirements or the Common Application. (You may submit an online application free of charge.)
- 2. Undergraduate Students: official secondary school academic records. (original and certified translations). Graduate Students: Official Transcripts (must be evaluated by ECE or WES if not US based) from all institutions previously attended, a professional resume, cover letter to the Admissions Committee, Official GMAT scores Ask about our GMAT waiver option! (Visit MBA.com for information about taking the GMAT,) two recommendations, and an interview.
- 3. Official Test Scores (SAT or ACT.) If English is not your native language, you must submit TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or IELTS (International English Language Testing Scores) scores, and this is required of all freshmen applicants. Requirements may be waived for transfer students contingent on college or university transcripts. Please note that **Moravian College** does **not** offer an English as a Second Language (ESL) program.
- 4. "Certification of Finances" form (included in application packet) that confirms that you and your sponsor understand the total cost of education, and there are adequate funds cover your educational expenses under normal conditions through the full program.
- 5. A letter from a bank official or bank statements must accompany all figures indicated on the "Certification of Finances" form for verification. However, all documents must be dated within 6 months of application.
- 6. **Proof of Financial Support**. The **Undergraduate** student must prove that they have at least the equivalent of \$61,614.00 (US) readily available to them for educational expenses. The Graduate student must prove that they have at least the equivalent of \$34,281.00 (US) readily available to them for educational expenses. The monies can be in any country and in any currency. Acceptable sources of financial resources are saving accounts, checking accounts, money market accounts, and certificates of deposit. If Moravian awards you a merit scholarship, you may deduct the amount of the scholarship from the total.
- 7. A letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor.
- 8. A personal statement or essay.
