HOW CAN I ESTABLISH AN ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND?

Speak to a member of Development & Alumni Engagement at Moravian University regarding your gift intentions. Our staffcan assist you in identifying the most attractive and effective designations for your gift.

As a scholarship donor, you choose the name of the scholarship as well as the criteria. Experienced Moravian staff is available to help you develop the criteria for your scholarship. Endowed scholarships are awarded to deserving students based upon the area of interest, leadership potential, merit, academic achievement, and/or other criteria.

Contributors of a scholarship fund are notified annually when the scholarship recipient(s) have been selected and informed of the name and hometown of the recipient. Recipients often write a thank-you note to the donor. Donors will be invited to the Scholarship Luncheon where they have the opportunity to meet the awarded students during the spring semester. We strive annually to provide an opportunity for donors to meet the students who will directly benefit from their commitment.
