

The Greek Life Expansion Application includes three components: a letter of intent from the group leader(s); a complete list of interested individuals; and a letter of support from the potential Faculty/Staff Advisor. Interested groups should identify one or two individuals to serve as a group leader(s) who will be the contact(s) for the Associate Dean of Students, as well as the Greek Life Expansion Committee (GLEC).

Completed applications are accepted by Student Life at any time. Applications submitted after September 15 and February 15 will be considered for review the subsequent semester. Upon receipt and initial review, the Associate Dean of Students will contact the group regarding the status of the application and when it will be reviewed by GLEC.

Letter of Intent

The letter of intent should outline the group's interest in fraternity or sorority expansion at Moravian College. Specifically, the letter should address the group's goals, as well as how they could potentially fill a void and/or strengthen Greek Life at Moravian. The letter should also address the potential benefits to the campus community if the interested group was approved to move forward in the expansion and chartering process.

The letter should indicate which umbrella organization the group is interested in becoming affiliated with. The group may choose to list up to three specific inter/national organizations within the umbrella organization they are particularly interested in. If specific inter/national organizations are listed, the group must provide a brief explanation as to why each organization was selected and how the organization correlates to the group's overarching goals, purpose, and potential niche on campus.

The letter should not exceed three pages and be signed by the group leader(s).

List of Interested Individuals

Each interested individual must be a full-time Moravian College student in good standing who has completed at least one semester at the College. Transfer students must have at least sophomore standing. Each individual must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above.

A list, in alphabetical order, of each individual's name, as well as the following information must be submitted:

- Moravian College ID Number
- Cell Phone Number
- Class year and Major
- Leadership/Involvement at Moravian
- Signature

By providing their signature, individuals are providing consent for the Associate Dean of Students to ensure they meet the GPA expectation. Any student, who has been previously initiated into a fraternity or sorority at Moravian College, shall be deemed ineligible to participate in the expansion process.

The list of interested individuals must include the minimum number that correlates with the appropriate umbrella organization:

- National Panhellenic Conference (NPC): 40 individuals
- National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC): 8 individuals
- North-American Inter-Fraternity Conference (NIC): 30 individuals
- National Association of Latino Fraternal Organizations (NALFO): 8 individuals
- National Multicultural Greek Council (NMGC): 8 individuals
- National Asian Pacific American Panhellenic Association (NAPA): 8 individuals

Letter of Support from Potential Faculty/Staff Advisor

The interested group should identify a potential advisor who must be a current, full-time faculty or staff member of Moravian College. The potential advisor should review the letter of intent, as well as the list of interested individuals.

The advisor's name and contact information should be included in the letter of intent. The application packet must include a signed, written statement from the individual of a willingness to serve and assist the group.
