For two weeks in May 2020, Moravian College students will travel to Japan to visit Hiroshima, Nagasaki, Osaka, and Kyoto. In these cities, students will visit important historical and cultural sites; learn about diverse Japanese perspectives about peace and war; and dip into fun and fascinating aspects of Japanese cuisine, history, entertainment, art, religion and culture. Moravian students will meet with college students, activists, and others to explore firsthand the continuing legacy, history, and urgent contemporary questions regarding war, peace, and nuclear weapons.
