

A chat with an admissions counselor is a great chance to learn more about Moravian University and show why you'd be a great fit. Here's how to prepare and make the most of it!

1. Research the College

- Explore Moravian online: Learn about our history, values, and what makes us unique.
- Check out our <u>academic programs</u>: Dive into your areas of interest and jot down questions.
- **Get a feel for campus life:** Look into <u>clubs, housing, dining,</u> and student activities.

2. Know the Admission Process

- **Understand requirements:** GPA, essays, recommendations—know what's needed! (P.S. We're test-optional.)
- Mark your calendar: Stay on top of <u>deadlines</u> for applications, scholarships, and housing.

3. Prep Your Questions

- **Academics:** Ask about <u>class sizes</u>, <u>research</u>, <u>internships</u>, and education abroad opportunities.
- Campus Life: Get the <u>inside scoop</u> on housing, dining, student resources, and campus safety.
- Financial Aid: Scholarships, grants, work-study—know your options.
- **Special initiatives:** Find out about <u>sustainability</u>, <u>wellness</u>, <u>diversity</u>, and <u>student success</u> programs.

4. Be Ready to Talk About You

- Common questions: Why Moravian? What are your academic and career goals? What activities are you involved in?
- **Self-Reflection:** Think about your strengths, interests, and experiences—what makes you stand out?

5. Stay Organized

- Take notes: Bring a notebook (or use your phone) to jot down important details.
- **Review materials:** Read brochures or the website to help guide your conversation.

6. During the Chat

- Be punctual: Arrive a few minutes early.
- Introduce yourself: Name, current school, and intended major—keep it simple.
- **Engage and be curious:** Show enthusiasm, listen actively, and ask your questions.
- Highlight your fit: Share why Moravian aligns with your goals and interests.
- **Be yourself!** We want to learn about the real you—your passions, goals, and what excites you about college!

7. After the Chat—Follow Up

- Say thank-you: A quick thank-you email or message goes a long way.
- **Reflect on what you learned:** How does Moravian feel to you?
- Stay in touch: Keep your counselor's contact info and reach out with any follow-up questions.
