



# How to Prepare for an Admissions Chat



A chat with an admissions counselor is a great chance to learn more about Moravian University and show why you'd be a great fit. Here's how to prepare and make the most of it!

## 1. Research the College

- **Explore Moravian online:** Learn about our history, values, and what makes us unique.
- **Check out our [academic programs](#):** Dive into your areas of interest and jot down questions.
- **Get a feel for campus life:** Look into [clubs](#), [housing](#), [dining](#), and [student activities](#).

## 2. Know the Admission Process

- **Understand requirements:** GPA, essays, recommendations—know what's needed! (P.S. We're test-optional.)
- **Mark your calendar:** Stay on top of [deadlines](#) for applications, scholarships, and housing.

## 3. Prep Your Questions

- **Academics:** Ask about [class sizes](#), [research](#), [internships](#), and [education abroad opportunities](#).
- **Campus Life:** Get the [inside scoop](#) on housing, dining, student resources, and campus safety.
- **Financial Aid:** Scholarships, grants, work-study—know [your options](#).
- **Special initiatives:** Find out about [sustainability](#), [wellness](#), [diversity](#), and [student success](#) programs.

## 4. Be Ready to Talk About You

- **Common questions:** Why Moravian? What are your academic and career goals? What activities are you involved in?
- **Self-Reflection:** Think about your strengths, interests, and experiences—what makes you stand out?

## 5. Stay Organized

- **Take notes:** Bring a notebook (or use your phone) to jot down important details.
- **Review materials:** Read brochures or the website to help guide your conversation.

## 6. During the Chat

- **Be punctual:** Arrive a few minutes early.
- **Introduce yourself:** Name, current school, and intended major—keep it simple.
- **Engage and be curious:** Show enthusiasm, listen actively, and ask your questions.
- **Highlight your fit:** Share why Moravian aligns with your goals and interests.
- **Be yourself!** We want to learn about the real you—your passions, goals, and what excites you about college!

## 7. After the Chat—Follow Up

- **Say thank-you:** A quick thank-you email or message goes a long way.
- **Reflect on what you learned:** How does Moravian feel to you?
- **Stay in touch:** Keep your counselor's contact info and reach out with any follow-up questions.
- **Expect to hear from us!** Your admissions counselor will be in touch—so keep an eye on your inbox!
