As standard among Institutional Review Boards in higher education, the following individuals associated with submissions of full IRB proposals must complete a course in research ethics, compliance, and responsible conduct of research.

- faculty who are principal investigators or co-principal investigators
- staff who are principal investigators or co-principal investigators
- students who are principal investigators or co-principal investigators
- faculty advisors to student research

PLEASE NOTE THAT THOSE SUBMITTING EXEMPTION REQUESTS DO NOT NEED TO COMPLETE THE TRAINING, ALTHOUGH DOING SO IS RECOMMENDED.
