FALL 2020 CLOSED CONCERTS

During the Fall 2020 semester, chamber ensemble concerts will occur as scheduled. However, these performances will be be offered as "Closed Concerts" and will follow these guidelines:

- Chamber ensemble performances will not be "open to the public" but will be presented as "Closed Concerts."
- They will be Zoomed and also offered face-to-face for a very limited amount of attendees.
- They will be held in Foy or Peter Halls.
- Performers and concert participants are required to practice social-distancing.
- There will be a set capacity/limit of total attendees allowed (to be determined by the Facilities Coordinator (Blair Flintom) and Music Dept. Chair (Dr. Neil Wetzel).
- Only Moravian College students, faculty and staff are eligible to attend in person.
- The first 4-5 rows of Foy Hall will be "roped off" and audience members will not be able to sit in those rows. The cap for in-person closed concerts in Foy Hall is limited to 25 people (performers, faculty, staff, and attendees).
- The benches on the floor of Peter Hall will be "roped off" and audience members will not be able to sit in those rows. Cap for closed concerts in Peter Hall is limited to 20 people (performers, faculty, staff, and attendees).
- The Zoom address for the concerts will be shared with all music majors, staff and faculty.
- Performers can share the Zoom address with family and friends.
- The Zoom address for the closed concert will not be published or shared with the general public.
- All in-person attendees will adhere to Moravian College's policies on social distancing and using masks.
