

THINGS YOU SHOULD REMEMBER/BRING

Study Abroad Program SPAIN

Summer 2022

- 1- Pay your balance of the program fee and buy your airline tickets.
- 2- Register for your courses. (You will be able to Register through AMOS in March or April 2022. These courses will be listed as a May Term Travel Course course)
- 3- Join our Facebook Page and Google Community.
- 4- Buy your books (if you need them) before you depart.
- 5- Check that your **passport** is valid and make copies of your passport.
- 6- Complete the International Office application form.
- 7- Bring with you your student I.D. (this is important)
- 8- Please inform the faculty advisor of any medical conditions that will require special attention.
- 9- Do not forget any medications you will need for the trip.
- 10- Travel Insurance (I will purchase a special health insurance for every student. However, if you are covered through a parents' health insurance bring a copy of the insurance card)
- 11- Pack Light: You can <u>check-in one</u> piece of luggage and it must <u>weigh less than 50 pounds</u>. If you need to check in more than one they will charge you an extra fee. If the luggage weighs more than 50 pounds you will get charged an extra fee.
- 12- You are allowed 2 carry-on items. A purse and a small piece of luggage.
- 13- Bring <u>light sweaters</u>. The temperature in Cordoba during the evening can drop to 60's Fahrenheit.
- 14- Bring comfortable shoes. People in Spain walk a lot! We will be doing a lot of walking!
- 15- Buy an adapter before you depart so you don't have to deal with it when you're there
- 16- Public transportation is very good in Spain. Everyone uses it on a regular basis.
- 17- Bring your computer. There is Wi-Fi at the residency and at the College.
- 18- Bring some spending money in euros. (50 or 100 euros is more than enough to have on you when we depart.)
- 19- Exchange dollars into euros at your local bank before traveling. (Don't bring too much cash! ATM machines work well in Spain! You can take money out from your US account at any ATM machine.)
- 20- Bring ATM card and credit card.
- 21- Credit cards Visa and Mastercard are accepted in most retail stores. American Express and Discover are not very popular in Spain.
- 22- Call credit card companies and bank to let them know that you will be in Spain from 5/13 to 5/23
- 23- <u>PHONES</u>: Make sure that you add international special rates on your cell phone for the time you will be in Spain. Be careful with roaming charges.
- 24- Download *Whatsapp* on your phone. With WI-FI you can text and talk locally and internationally free of charge. Remember that in your room you have WI-FI so you can Skype.
- 25- Bring a small purse for change because you'll have so many coins you won't know what to do with them.
