



## ORGANIZATIONAL HOUSING OVERVIEW

Organizational Housing at Moravian College is designed to provide environmental support to the academic and co-curricular elements of the College. It is an opportunity for active members of a USG recognized club/organization or Moravian College athletic team to establish a living space that meets the goals and interests of the group.

Organizational Housing aims to:

- Provide a means for resident students to exercise a greater degree of control and responsibility for the creation of their own unique living experiences
- Increase the breadth and depth of student engagement in campus activities
- Enrich the learning environment for all members of the campus community
- Create a more direct link between co-curricular pursuits and the residential experience

### **Organizational Housing Timeline**

- **Friday, February 28, 2020 at 4:30PM:** Complete Housing Status Application (as individuals).
- **Friday, February 28, 2020 at 4:30PM:** Application Packet Due to the Office of Housing.
- **Monday, March 16 & Tuesday, March 17, 2020:** Organizational House Leader & Office of Housing meeting.
- **Friday, March 20, 2020:** Decision letters sent to House Leaders and Advisors via email.
- **Monday, March 23, 2020:** Accept or Decline letter due to the Office of Housing.

### **Selection Criteria**

The Office of Housing will review applications and may consult with the USG advisor and/or Athletics. In addition to merit of the application and vibrancy of the group, housing placements will be determined based on the following order:

- Total housing points
- Lottery numbers will be used in the event that multiple groups have the same number of housing

Similar to the off-campus housing process, members' conduct history and GPA may be considered in order to assign the strongest groups to these community spaces.

Decisions are based solely on the members who appear in this application. Substitutions may not be made after the application is submitted. If an intended member of the house withdrawals from the group prior to General Housing Selection, the entire application will be void. **A member whose name appears on the housing list will not be approved for off-campus housing.**

**HOUSE MEMBER ROSTER**

If an intended member of the house withdraws from the group prior to General Housing Selection, the entire application will be void. **A member whose name appears on the housing list will not be approved for off-campus housing.**

**MEMBER ACKNOWLEDGEMENT**

By signing below, I agree to living as part of a group in Organizational Housing, and understand that I am no longer eligible for off-campus housing or participation in General Housing Selection. I understand that if I choose not to live in Organizational Housing, the application will be void and all applicants will be entered into General Housing Selection. If a vacancy becomes available in the space, the Office of Housing will notify the residents of the organization space and provide 5-days for the group to identify a student to fill the vacancy. If a student is not identified after 5-days, the Office of Housing may assign a student to fill the vacancy at any time even if the student is not part of the organization.
