2024-2025 ORGANIZATIONAL HOUSING OVERVIEW

Organizational Housing at Moravian University is an opportunity for members of a USG recognized club/organization, athletic team or military affiliated group to establish a living space that meets the goals and interests of the group.

Organizational Housing aims to:

- Provide a means for resident students to exercise a greater degree of control and responsibility for the creation of their own unique living experiences
- Increase the breadth and depth of student engagement in campus activities
- Enrich the learning environment for all members of the campus community
- Create a more direct link between co-curricular pursuits and the residential experience

Organizational Housing Timeline

- **Friday, February 23 at 4:30PM:** [Complete Housing Status Application](#) (as individuals).
- **Friday, February 23 at 4:30PM:** [House Leader](#) and [Member Application](#) due (see details below)
- **Monday, March 4 & Tuesday, March 5:** Organizational House Leader & Office of Housing meeting.
- **Friday, March 8:** Decision letters sent to House Leaders and Advisors via email.
- **Friday, March 15:** Accept or Decline letter due to the Office of Housing.

Selection Criteria

The Office of Housing will review applications and may consult with the USG advisor and/or Athletics. Housing placements will be determined based on the following order:

- Total housing points
- Lottery numbers will be used in the event that groups have the same number of housing points.

Members' conduct history and GPA may be considered to assign the strongest groups to these spaces.

Decisions are based solely on the members who appear in this application. Substitutions may not be made after the application is submitted. If an intended member of the house withdraws prior to General Housing Selection, the entire application will be void. **A member whose name appears on the housing list will not be approved for off-campus housing.**

ORGANIZATIONAL HOUSING APPLICATIONS

Housing Leader Application - The House Leader serves as a connection between the group and the Office of Housing. The designated House Leader is responsible for meeting with the Office of Housing staff on Monday, March 6 or Tuesday, March 7, to share more about the group's interest and ask questions, so a decision can be made regarding the status of the application.

Member Application - *Each* member of the organization should complete this application.

Both the Housing Leader Application and Member Application must be submitted by 4:30PM on Friday, February 23 to be considered for Organizational Housing.
