

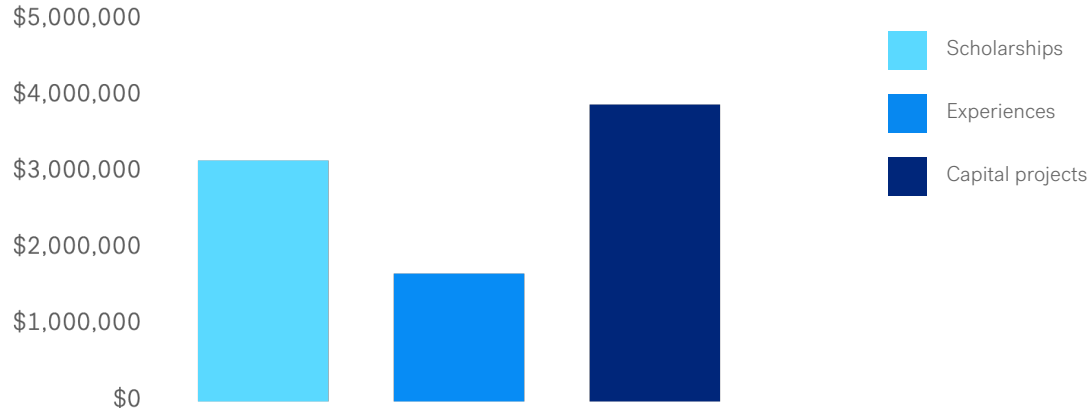
Fiscal Year in Review

The 2024–2025 fiscal year (July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025) was a remarkable year of growth and new beginnings, and none of our success would have been possible without the generous support and dedication of our community.

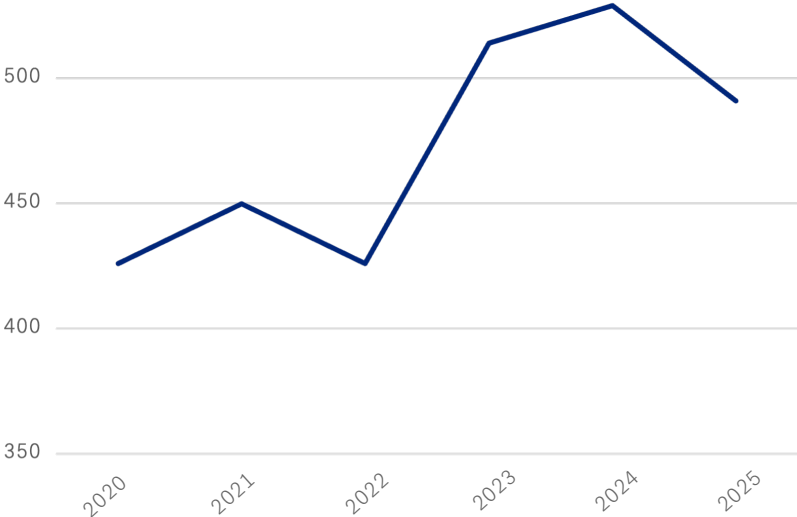
This year, Moravian University raised a total of \$8,721,798 received from 3,701 total supporters, including 866 new supporters. Total philanthropic support includes \$1,183,046 raised for the Moravian Scholarship Fund, our largest source of unrestricted aid, which helps make students' education affordable and enhances their experience.

UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT

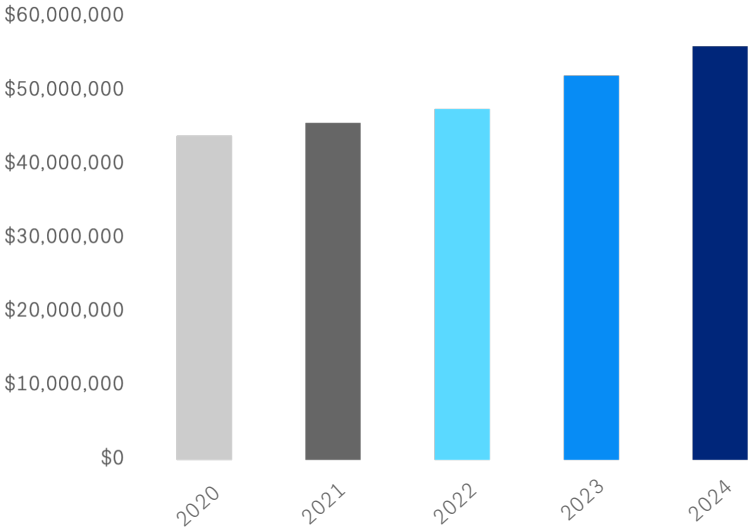


Moravian University was recently recognized as the fastest-growing university in the mid-Atlantic region and the fifth fastest-growing university in the nation.

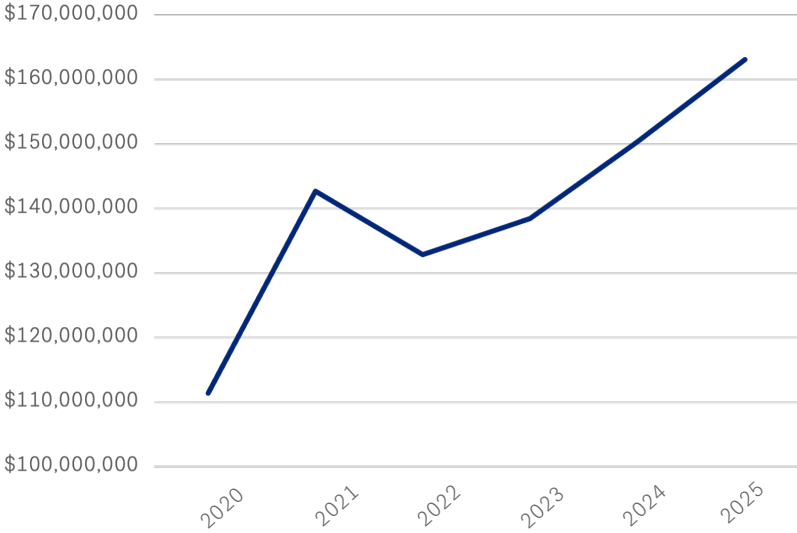
TOTAL INSTITUTIONAL AID DISTRIBUTED
