Financial Aid and Billing Information for Students Enrolling in 2018-2019

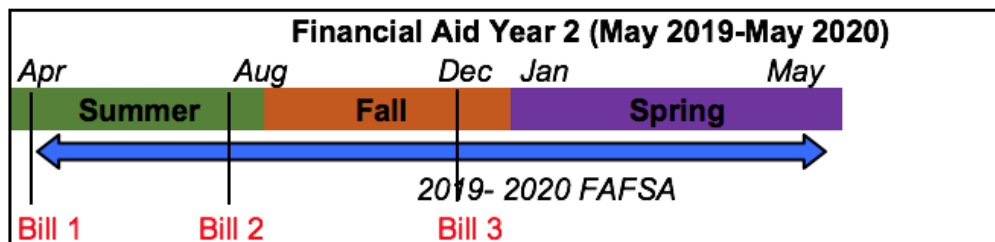
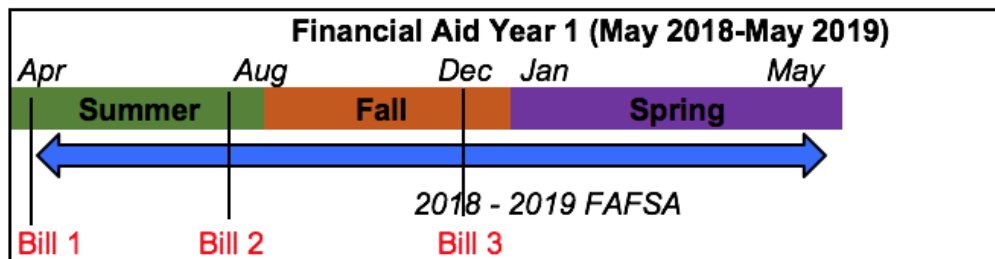
(Starting May 2018, August 2018, January 2019)

Costs

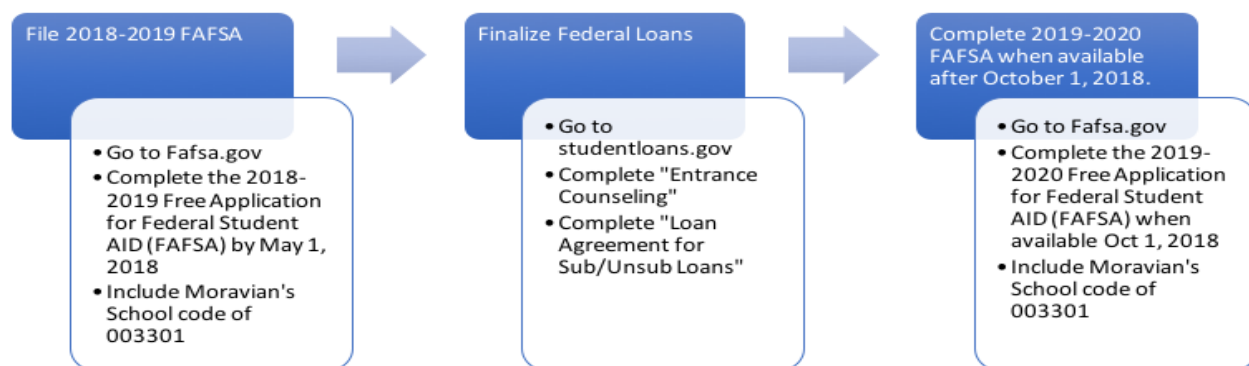
- Flat rate for the 2018-19 year for full time enrollment-\$17,000 with split into 3 equal billing periods
- Part Time enrollment (possible after the 1st semester) is \$2,000/course
- Billing and payment due dates will be issued May 2018, July 2018, and December 2018 and will be mailed and available electronically
- Cycle repeats each year (1st 2 years mapped visually below)

Financial Aid

- Students will complete a FAFSA each year beginning with the 2018-2019 year and receive a financial aid package each year
- Financial aid for the program is split evenly among the billing periods (June 2018, August 2018, January 2019)
- Refund checks may be used for other school expenses and will be issued no later than 2 weeks after financial aid has been disbursed at the beginning of each semester
- Half-Time enrollment (6 credits) each semester is required to maintain FA eligibility and loan deferment

Additional Financing Options

Some DAT students will require additional funding to assist with living expenses. The following financing options to assist you in paying for your tuition and education related expenses:

| Loan Type | Fees | Interest Rate | Credit/Income Requirements |
|--|--------|---------------|---|
| Federal Graduate PLUS Loan | 4.264% | 7% | Credit Check only, no Income, can obtain an endorser if needed |
| Private Education Loans (Lenders vary) | Varies | Varies | Varies by lender, generally includes credit check and income, parent or other co-signer can be used |


