

Student Health Insurance

Moravian College undergraduate students, full time graduate students (9 or more credits), and all Moravian Theological Seminary students are required to have health insurance. If you do not currently have health insurance, there is the option to enroll and purchase coverage. The health plan is provided by United Healthcare Insurance Company. If you are using your current health insurance, it is advised that out of state students should notify their health insurance carrier that they may need services in Bethlehem while enrolled as a student.

As part of this requirement, undergraduate students, full time graduate students (9 or more credits), and all Moravian Theological Seminary students are required to show proof of health insurance or enroll and purchase the College sponsored plan. In order to waive this coverage or confirm your enrollment in the College sponsored plan, please follow the instructions below:

1. Go to www.firststudent.com
2. Select Moravian College
3. To enroll in the plan click on “Enroll Now-Health Insurance”
4. To waive out of the plan click on “Waive Your School’s Health Insurance”
5. Enter all required information from your health insurance card in order to complete the waiver process
6. An email copy of your submission will be sent to your Moravian College email address. Save this message as proof of your submission.
7. If enrolled in the plan, this account will provide a copy of your health insurance card, check claim status, file medical claims and review the details of the plan
8. If you have any questions, please call 1-800-346-4075 ext. 1452 or email Moravian@rcmd.com. They will be glad to help you with any questions that you may have.

If you waive the health insurance coverage and provide the required information, you will not be billed for the plan. If you enroll in the plan, you will be billed on your Student Account for the applicable charge. If you fail to wave or enroll in the plan and take **no action**, you will be billed on your Student Account for the applicable plan and be automatically enrolled in the plan.

Plan details such as deadlines, brochures, benefits, and coverage can be found at www.firststudent.com. Coverage will begin on August 1, 2018 and go through July 31, 2019.

International students are strongly recommended to have an international health insurance plan that covers them while attending school in the United States.
