ACADEMIC APPEAL PROCESS

Students who do not meet program requirements for progressing in the program of study in nursing (MSN/MSN NP/DNP) have the right to submit an appeal to the Student Development and Progression (SDP) Committee. The process is as follows:

- 1. Upon receipt of an email from the members of SDP, students should meet with their academic advisor(s) to discuss their academic circumstances.
- 2. Students must inform the faculty of the SDP Committee of their intent to appeal by the date identified in the email/letter from SDP.
- 3. Students are required to obtain a current unofficial transcript and write a letter (not to exceed 2 pages) explaining the basis for their appeal and plan of action for future success.
- 4. Students must submit the documents electronically to SDP faculty members and their advisor(s) via email by the deadline specified in the letter from SDP.
