The Moravian University Health Center is managed by St. Luke's Hospital through the St. Luke's Hospital Occupational Health Program and provides a variety of services during the fall and spring terms. STUDENT HEALTH RECORDS

Student health records are maintained in a shared record within the Health Center's EMR (electronic medical record, called Pyramed). It is the student's responsibility to keep required health documents current in the electronic system in accordance with the School of Nursing Policy. The School of Nursing will have access to these files and may need to release some or all of the health records to the affiliating clinical agencies that may request them. A consent form is signed by the student prior to enrollment to release health forms as needed.
