

# COVID Residence Hall Expectations

Phases are not tied to the College's reopening plan. Residents will receive communication from the Office of Housing if and when, a phase change occurs.



## Visitation

### Phase A

Only residents of a space (room or suite) are permitted in that space.  
Residents from other halls, commuters, and non-Moravians (with exception of family during move in/out) are not permitted inside residence halls.  
Residents should only access and utilize their assigned space (room or suite) and community bathroom.

### Phase B

Residential students may visit each other within the same residence hall.\*  
Residents from other halls, commuters, and non-Moravians (with exception of family during move in/out) are not permitted inside residence halls.  
Student rooms (doubles and singles) may not exceed two individuals at a given time.  
Roommates should discuss expectations for visitors.

### Phase C

Residential students may visit other residence halls.\*  
Commuters and non-Moravians (with exception of family during move in/out) are not permitted inside residence halls.  
Student rooms (doubles and singles) may not exceed two individuals at a given time.  
Roommates should discuss expectations for visitors.

### Phase D

Moravian students may visit each other in residence halls.\*  
Non-Moravians (with exception of family during move in/out) are not permitted inside residence halls.  
Student rooms (doubles and singles) may not exceed two individuals at a given time.  
Roommates should discuss expectations for visitors.

## Common Area Usage (areas accessible to all building residents)

### Phase A

Spaces are closed.  
Residents should remain in their assigned room.

### Phase B-D

Spaces are accessible (within occupancy limits).  
Residents should sanitize the space when finished.

## Greek Houses

### Phase A-C

Access to the chapter house is limited to house residents.  
Chapter Presidents must work with the Office of Greek Life to access chapter house.

### Phase D

Access to the chapter house is limited to chapter members.  
Non-Moravians, including chapter advisors and volunteers, are not permitted in chapter house.

## Hand washing, physical distancing, and mask-wearing is required in all phases.

### \*Adhere to these guidelines when approaching another resident's space:

- Remain in the doorway, if possible
- Seek approval to enter from resident
- Wear a mask
- Maintain physical distance

### Mask-wearing is required unless an individual is:

- In their assigned room with no visitor(s) present
- Eating and/or drinking
- Showering and/or brushing teeth

### Residents of suites should discuss expectations of common space usage:

- Frequency of sanitization of high touch areas
- Sharing of personal items
- Preparation and eating of food
- Visitation within individual rooms (in phases B-D)

### Common areas of suites are limited to the assigned residents of the suite in all phases.

Visitors should not be in the common area of suites including restrooms.
