Hand washing, physical distancing, and mask-wearing is required in all phases.

*Adhere to these guidelines when approaching another resident's space:

- Remain in the doorway, if possible
- Seek approval to enter from resident
- Wear a mask
- Maintain physical distance

Mask-wearing is required unless an individual is:

- In their assigned room with no visitor(s) present
- Eating and/or drinking
- Showering and/or brushing teeth

Residents of suites should discuss expectations of common space usage:

- Frequency of sanitization of high touch areas
- Sharing of personal items
- Preparation and eating of food
- Visitation within individual rooms (in phases B-D)

Common areas of suites are limited to the assigned residents of the suite in all phases.

Visitors should not be in the common area of suites including restrooms.
