- Completed 3 credit hours in English composition and 3 credit hours in English literature (American, British, or World – ENG 101, 102, 103, 104 and some special topics) – these credits may be part of the 48 initial credits and can be met by the Writing 100 course & the Literature requirement at Moravian
- Completed a successful Stage 1&2 field placement.
- Have an original transcript on file in the center for Graduation Studies & Continuing Education.
- Have two letters of recommendation on file in the center for Graduation Studies & Continuing Education.

**Candidates applying to the intern program:** Must pass the Praxis exams **prior to** being formally accepted into the intern program.**Candidates applying to the MAT program who have an undergraduate degree in the subject in which they are seeking teacher certification** can do those exams at any time during the program.**Candidates applying to the MAT program who DO NOT have an undergraduate degree in the subject in which they are seeking teacher certification** need to pass the Subject Area Content Exam before being formally admitted into the MAT program. Fundamental Content Knowledge Exam can be done at any time during the program. Students can take up to two courses as a non-matriculated student.**NOTES:** 1. Students will be placed in field experiences only when all background checks (the FBI Fingerprint, the Pennsylvania State Police Criminal Records Check, and Child Abuse History Clearance) are clear of record.

2. The Pennsylvania Department of Education requires that candidates for a teaching certificate be U.S. citizens, or have declared intent to file for citizenship. This does not apply to candidates seeking foreign language certification. PDE may not certify anyone who has been convicted of a felony.
