James Scifers, DScPT, PT, SCS, LAT, ATC

**Professor & Master of Science in Athletic Training Program Director
Chair, Department of Rehabilitation Sciences**

Learn from the National Athletic Trainers' Association's 2018 Sayers "Bud" Miller Distinguished Educator (the association's highest teaching award). Scifers was recognized as a NATA Most Distinguished Athletic Trainer, received the Athletic Training Educator of the Year from the North Carolina Athletic Trainers' Association in 2014, and received the NATA 2017 Professional Development Excellence Award. Dr. Scifers co-authored the Gfeller-Waller Concussion Awareness Act in North Carolina.

His scholarship includes textbook authoring and contributions, 30+ articles, and more than 300 professional presentations in athletic training and physical therapy. Scifers' areas of research interests are the sacroiliac joint, manual therapy, and therapeutic modalities. He holds his bachelor's in physical education/athletic training from East Stroudsburg University, his MPT from Emory University, and his DScPT from University of Maryland-Baltimore.



David Wilkenfeld, EdD, LAT, ATC

Assistant Professor & Clinical Education Coordinator

Dr. Wilkenfeld serves as the Coordinator of Clinical Education for the Master of Science in Athletic Training Program. Previously, he was an athletic trainer, preceptor, and coordinator of clinical education at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts. Dr. Wilkenfeld was named an Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016 by the North Carolina Athletic Trainers' Association, served on the Board of Representatives, and was selected as a

fellow in the inaugural class of the NCATA Leadership Institute. His research interests center around hearing health and injury prevention in the performing arts. Dr. Wilkenfeld has over 15 professional presentations in athletic training and performing arts medicine, and contributed to a national textbook that is currently in press. Wilkenfeld's academic interests include performing arts medicine, human anatomy, and evaluation and management of the foot and ankle. David holds his bachelor's in exercise biology from UC Davis, his MSAT from University of Tennessee at Chattanooga, and his EdD from University of North Carolina at Greensboro.
