All full-time undergraduate students are guaranteed and are expected to live on-campus or commute from their permanent address. Off-campus housing is offered to a *select* number of eligible students during the spring semester for the upcoming academic year.

BECOMING AN OFF-CAMPUS RESIDENT

APPLY | MARCH 1

Submit your Housing Status Application during Housing Pre-Selection.

RECEIVE APPROVAL | MARCH 15

A select number of eligible applicants will be approved for release.

FIND OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING

Approved students may sign a lease once released and provide the College with their off-campus address before August 1.

The number of off-campus releases changes year-to-year.

LESS THAN 5% OF STUDENTS LIVE OFF-CAMPUS

The College anticipates releasing approximately 50 students for the 2019-2020 academic year.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS?

- Junior or senior, or 20 years of age by the first day of the fall semester
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Good financial and conduct standing

CURRENT OFF CAMPUS RESIDENTS MUST REAPPLY FOR RELEASE

Off-Campus residents who do not reapply will be changed to on-campus or commuter status, based on their permanent address.
