STUDENT PERSONAL TRANSPORTATION TO CLINICAL ASSIGNMENT SITES

Beginning with Nursing 212, students will be responsible for providing their own transportation to clinical sites. These sites are generally within a 40-mile radius of the University. Clinical placements begin at variable times at different locations; therefore, students need to have their own automobile on campus for this use. In the event a student is unable to have their own vehicle, they will be expected to make their own travel arrangements. The University or individual nursing faculty will not provide transportation for this purpose. Students are expected to have a valid driver's license. Students are not asked by the School of Nursing and Public Health / University to transport other students to clinical sites.
