GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

By faculty policy, only those students who are certified as having satisfied all of the requirements for the baccalaureate degree are eligible to receive a diploma. In addition to the requirements of the University, nursing students are required to complete the following requirements:

- 1. Students are required to meet progression requirements for their respective programs.
 - TUG students must have a cumulative quality point average (QPA) of 3.00 or better, a natural science cumulative QPA of 2.67 or better in courses required by the major, and a nursing QPA of 3.00 or better.
 - PB students must have a nursing QPA and overall QPA of 3.0 or better.
 - RN-BSN students must have thirty-two course units completed with an overall Quality Point Average (QPA) of not less than 2.00, at least 8 course units must be completed at Moravian University, and six nursing courses must be completed at Moravian University with a grade of C or better.
- 2. Satisfactory clinical evaluations in all nursing courses.
- 3. Evidence of successful completion of all curriculum requirements, including but not limited to:
 - a. Completion of standardized assessments incorporated in the nursing curriculum (see Section 3 ATI Policy)
